Literacy

The children have listened to the story The Enormous Turnip this week and have learnt to retell the story using actions and repeated refrains. Children have drawn their own story maps and will be changing aspects of the story to make their own next week.

Phonics

- L1 children have practised their rhyming skills by making rhyming matching pairs
- L3 children learnt the GPCs ai and ee
- L3 children revisited the GPCs ee and igh and practised writing tricky words I, no and go.
- L6 children learnt the GPC gn making the /n/ sound



Rec: Children have been comparing amounts saying when there are more, fewer or the same amount of objects and pictures.

Y1: Children have been learning number bonds to 5 and 6 and writing these as an addition sentence, They used practical resources to partition these amounts into two groups in different ways.

Y2: Children have been revising number bonds to 5, 6, 10 and 20 using addition and subtraction to write as number sentences.

<u>Topic</u>

In Art, children looked at artwork created by cavemen in the Stone Age and talked about what they could see in the artwork and how they were make. Children used chalk and charcoal to make artwork like cavemen. In History, children thought about how we know about events in the past. They learnt about Samuel Pepys, who kept a diary during the great fire of London. The children then decided what would make a good source of information. In PSHE children listened to the story We Look After Property linking to that Golden Rule. Children added this rule to their poster. In Science, children learnt about humans as animals and the different body parts we have. We sang Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes and children labelled a picture of a person and thought about what we used our body parts for.
