<u>Literacy</u>

The children have told their own version of the story The Enormous Turnip using story language and have made sentences to write their story.

<u>Phonics</u>

L1 – children have practised oral blending and segmenting using robot voices – e.g c-a-t- cat!

L3 – children learnt the GPCs igh and oa and long oo

L3 – children revisited the GPCs short oo, ar and or and practised writing tricky words he, she, me.

L6 – children learnt the GPC kn making the /n/ sound

<u>Maths</u>

Rec: Children have been looking at measures and have been ordering buttons by size, comparing mass using balance scales and using mathematical vocabulary to describe volume and capacity.

Y1: Children have been learning the number bonds to 10 using numicon pairs and singing our number bond song.Y2: Children have been revising number bonds to 10 and 20 and have answered subtraction sums using these number bonds.

<u>Topic</u>

In Art, children learnt about tonal value and made a scale from dark to light using crayon, chalk and charcoal. They used charcoal and chalk to add shadow and light to 3D shapes. In History, children looked at the reasons the great fire spread so quickly and thought about how London could be rebuilt to stop a disaster like this happening again. In PSHE, children learnt about the UNICEF Convention of the Rights of the Child and found out about some of the special rights they have as children.
