

## QUEENSWOOD SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST FOR JUNIOR BOYS

- WINTER      Grey long trousers  
Long-sleeved grey shirt  
Grey pullover, neck-bordered with school colours  
Grey socks  
Tie  
Optional in winter - scarf, hat in suitable school colours
- SUMMER     Grey shorts (or trousers)  
Grey short-sleeved shirt  
Tie
- COATS        Striped blazer with embroidered school badge (ESSENTIAL)  
Outdoor coat : PLAIN in dark green, black or grey  
(Anoraks, wax jackets, duffel coats are acceptable, providing that they are plain and not patterned.) Motifs and logos are not suitable
- SHOES        WINTER: Plain black shoes  
Waterproof boots are needed in the inclement weather  
Trainers with stripes, logos, flashing lights etc are unsuitable - plain black shoe-type trainers are allowed, but they must have a soft sole and not make a noise on school floor surfaces.  
SUMMER: Plain black sandals or shoes
- SPORT        Plain white cotton shorts (with sufficient room to move freely)  
Regulation T-shirt and sweatshirt in House-Colours  
Black pumps (without laces)  
White socks to change into (not liners, but sports ankle socks)  
Training shoes designed for running specifically  
Swimming trunks, above the knee  
Green tracksuit bottoms (from Uniform Shop)  
Pump Bag (not larger bag) to hang on classroom peg

All items of sportswear must have clear name labels and kept in a pump bag on your child's own peg in the cloakroom when not in use.

### GENERAL APPEARANCE:

Watches are allowed, but no other items of jewellery should be worn.

HAIR - discretion should be applied to style and length. No closely shaved, closely cropped styles. Gel should not be used in order to make hair spiky.

<u>WINTER</u>	Green regulation tunic (Year 5 and 6 may wear a green skirt) White long-sleeved blouse and tie Green cardigan, neck-bordered with school colours Green woolly tights or $\frac{3}{4}$ length green socks. Optional in winter- scarf, hat in suitable school colours
<u>SUMMER</u>	Regulation green and white striped cotton dress White socks
<u>COATS</u>	Striped blazer with embroidered school blazer ESSENTIAL Outdoor coat : PLAIN in dark green, black or grey (Anoraks, wax jackets, duffel coats are acceptable, providing that they are plain and not patterned)
<u>SHOES</u>	WINTER: Plain black shoes with flat heels. Open toe/sling-back shoes are not acceptable for outdoor winter use Sensible waterproof boots should be worn in inclement weather. ALL pupils must have a pair of suitable indoor shoes when it is snowing. SUMMER: sensible flat white/brown/black sandals (Open-toe and sling-back sandals are unsuitable)
<u>SPORT</u>	Plain white cotton shorts (with sufficient room to move freely) Regulation T-shirt and sweatshirt in House-Colours Black pumps (without laces) White socks to change into (not liners, but sports ankle socks) Training shoes designed for running specifically One-piece Swimming Costume Green tracksuit bottoms (from Uniform Shop) Pump Bag (not larger bag) to hang on classroom peg

All items of sportswear must be clearly labeled and kept in a pump bag on your child's own peg in the cloakroom when not in use.

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### GENERAL APPEARANCE:

- Nail varnish is forbidden
- Jewellery, except plain gold stud earrings and watches must not be worn in school
- Items MUST be removed for sports activities
- Hair ribbons and slides must be in school colours - red, green and yellow AND please ensure that hair decorations are sensible. Long hair must be tied back or worn with an "Alice Band"- in school colours

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
