We listened to the story Rama and Sita about a princess who was captured by the evil Ravana. The moral of the story was that good always triumphs over evil. The children thought of adjectives to describe the characters and wrote character descriptions in sentences.

Phonics

Maths

Rec: We have been finding one more that given numbers in different ways.

Y1: Children have written and demonstrated number bonds to 7, 8 and 10.

Y2: Children have said how many more to the next 10 and used this to solve simple problems.



Topic

In Art, children have made pinch-pot diva lamps using clay. They pinched around the edges to make a dish shape and used clay tools to decorate. In PSHE, children learnt about the difference between a little problem, a tricky problem and a serious problem. They thought about ways they could solve little problems themselves and why it was important to ask for help for tricky and serious problems. In History, children looked at photos and newspaper articles about space travel and thought of historical questions they could ask to find more information about these events. In Science, children thought about what materials different objects were made of.
