

## Literacy

At the beginning of the week, children listened to the sounds of fireworks and thought of onomatopoeias for firework sounds. They then used these to write sentences.

Children have used inference skills to look at a page from our new story Look Up! The children have met a little girl in her space themed bedroom and have made predictions about her character by looking for clues in the picture from the story.

## Phonics

L2 – Children have been introduced to the sounds and letters i, n, m & d

L3 – children revisited the all L3 GPCs

L6 – children learnt the how to add the suffix -est to words ending in y

## Maths

Rec: We have been finding one less than given numbers in different ways and jumped back on number lines.

Y1: Children have revised number bonds to 10 and have worked out subtractions from 10

Y2: Children have been using number bonds to solve addition and subtraction problems crossing the 10s boundary.

## Topic

In DT, children investigated the moving parts of different vehicles. They learnt that wheels spin on axles held together on the chassis. Children labelled the different parts of a car. In PSHE, children learnt ways to keep their bodies healthy, this week we focussed on exercise and rest. Children thought of ways that they can exercise their body and what is important for a bedtime routine. In History, children learnt about some of the events that happened during the space race and placed these on a timeline. In Science, children thought about what materials different objects were made of. They went for a walk around the town spotting uses for everyday materials.
