## <u>Literacy</u>

The children listened to the story Vlad and the Great Fire of London. Vlad, a flea, who lives between ears of Boxton the rat follows the story of the great fire of London as it happens. The children talked about the characters and used adjectives to describe them.

#### **Phonics**

L1 – children played games to learn to tune into the initial sounds of words. They matched items for Dana Dinosaur starting with d-d-d and items for Tamsin Tiger starting with t-t-t.

L3 – children learnt the GPCs y, x, z, zz, qu and ch

L3 – children revisited the GPCs sh, th (voiced as in with and unvoiced as in moth) and ng

L6 - children learnt the GPCs dge and ge saying /j/



Rec: Children continued to play matching games saying which pictures and patterns were the same and which were different.

Y1: Children have been securing their knowledge of numbers 1-20 by counting forwards and backwards and finding one more and one less than a given number. We have also introduced counting in 10s.

Y2: Children counted forwards and backwards in 10s and used 'spider counting' on a 100 squared by moving up and down to add and subtract 10.

# <u>Topic</u>

In Art, children made gestural drawings and experimented with the lines, shapes and effects they could make using charcoal and chalk. We talked about warm and cool colours. In History, children learned about life in the 17th century and found out about some of the jobs people might have. In PSHE children listened to the story We are Kind and Helpful linking to that Golden Rule. Children added this rule to their poster. In Science children learnt about the features of different animal groups and sorted animals into the correct group. In RE we continued to learn our poem for the Harvest Festival. In Music, the children began learning songs to perform at the Harvest Festival.
