<u>Literacy</u>

Children thought about what they might see at autumn time including hedgehogs, squirrels, leaves, trees, rain, sun and conkers. Children thought of adjectives to describe these and Y2 thought of appropriate verbs and adverbs to create extended noun sentences. We put these together to make an autumn poem.

Phonics

- L1 children have continued to practise oral blending and segmenting, they have been doing robot talking and robot walking
- $\mbox{L3}-\mbox{children}$ learnt the GPCs ar and ur and writing tricky words no, go and I
- L3 children revisited the GPCs ur and ow and practised writing tricky words was, my, you, they
- L6 children learnt the grapheme wr to make the /r/ sound.

<u>Maths</u>

Rec: We have been focusing on the numbers 1,2,3 and spotting these numbers in the environment. Children have subitised (said how many without counting) amounts to 3 and have practised their number formation Y1: Children have been learning about measuring length and using language longer, shorter, taller to compare. Children have measured using cm and a trundle wheel. Y2: Children have measured length and height in cm and have drawn lines of different lengths.

<u>Topic</u>

In Art, children have made observational drawings of autumn leaves, looking closely at colours and patterns they can see. In PSHE, children have learnt about the golden rule 'We are honest' and spoke about why it is important to always tell the truth after listening to the story The Boy Who Cried Wolf. In History, they finished their booklet about the Great Fire of London and shared what they had learnt in celebration assembly.
